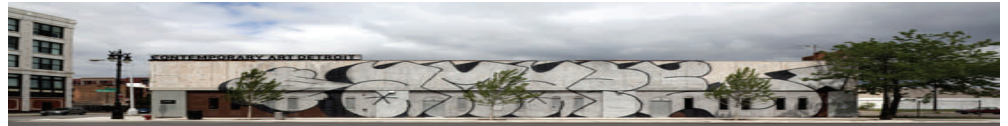


# Windows to the World (WTW)
